**Chat Log** (Board Questions and Responses)

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Question: Why do we need so much in the savings account? What are we saving for?

**Response (Rich P.).** A chunk of it serves as an "emergency reserve" position, Craig. If we had to cancel a conference without being able to lean on Force Majeuer (like we did for the 2020 conferences)--the Hotel commitments/fees would have been nearly \$250,000. We need to have enough in the bank to cover such an event...as "event cancellation insurance" doesn't really cover all situations.

**Question:** Do we have a max amount then of how much we want to keep in the bank for that emergency reserve? **Response (Rich P.)**. Yes, each year, the Fiscal Committee determines what that amount should be.

**Question:** With respect to our Income, we put a lot of effort into our training programs; have we benchmarked what we charge for participation in those classes against comparable organizations? The income from training seems low.

**Response** (Rich P.). John, we have in the past, done such benchmarking. Training revenues don't fully reflect training-related fees, as members often use "passes" from their higher level of membership toward training classes.

# **Chat (De-Carbonization):**

**Tyler**: Expanding off the first bullet, does that mean we might actually measure the collective impacts of PLMA on carbon reduction? As in GHG reduced or new MW under management? Would be interesting to talk about starting to quantify and assess the impact of the PLMA community YoY as we all work to decarbonize.

**Rich P.**: Tyler, that hasn't been defined yet...but I'm sure that Rich/Robin/Christine would love to get some input from you on the idea you pose.

**Robin:** Thanks for the question and suggestion, Tyler Rogers (Guest)! As Rich says, we have not yet explicitly defined what the "link" might look. We identified a clear need for a better qualitative link. Whether or not we take the next step of starting to quantify might be dependent on how far the Decarb Task Force wants/can go. Would be great to hear more about your ideas -- and perhaps have you join the Task Force!

Tyler: Sounds fun. Let's keep talking Robin Maslowski.

**Laurie:** Tyler, the "future of EmPOWER Maryland" is moving to GHG abatement vs. MWH reduction goals. MW or Peak MW reductions are part of the discussion - still early and we have not determined how to value. It will likely be small - possibly the impact of the "dirtiest" plant(s).

**Rich P.:** Tyler, that hasn't been defined yet...but I'm sure that Rich/Robin/Christine would love to get some input from you on the idea you pose.
